1. Welcome and Attendance

Present:

2. VICTIM SUPPORT

- The recent rape cases reported need to be followed very closely and hope for suspects to be brought to book

3. POLICE REPORT - Captain Hlongwane/ Colonel Mhlongo

- The sudden spike in crime has been noted compared to last year
- The following crimes are currently of concern:
 - Theft out of motor vehicle and malicious damage to property cases continue to be a challenge
 - Aggravated Robbery has seen the biggest increase
 - Business robbery also saw a sudden spike
 - Trio crimes are slightly up when compared to last year

4. EMPD - Supt Glenn

- 28 tickets issued for the Kloof/Talisman stop street enforcement
- 12 fines issued for stop street enforcement on Regent street, Request for better signage noted
- Reports received at previous meeting of Taxi issue by the Italian club on Marais rd. was dealt with
- Issue of drinking in public in Senderwood was also addressed
- Reports of vagrants in Kirkby rd. was checked and no structures were found

5. WARD COUNCILLOR

- Jill reported that the signage issue on Regent str was escalated but no progress from EMM
- Noise complaints that have been received have been escalated and dept of environmental health is being arranged to address the problem
- A concern was raised about the crimes taking place in regent street area SAPS indicated that WO Ndubane the sector 1 commander is to address the issue
